

## **Foothill Crossing - Who to contact for questions or concerns**

If you have an HOA-related question, concern, or suggestion, please reach out. HOA committees and their respective chairperson and members are posted on the HOA website. If you are not sure who to contact, then start with the Board of Directors (BOD). However, for a faster response, reach out to the following contacts first on these topics:

1. Contact the **Property Manager** for the following (via email: [foothillscrossinghoa@gmail.com](mailto:foothillscrossinghoa@gmail.com)) :
  - a) HOA annual dues payment
  - b) Issues related to the landscaping and maintenance of the entrance sign and common areas
  - c) Issues related to the Storm Water Protection basins
  - d) Issues related to the care and maintenance of the street trees
  
2. Contact the **Board of Directors** (BOD) for questions related to the following (via email: [foothillscrossinghoa@gmail.com](mailto:foothillscrossinghoa@gmail.com)) :
  - a) The annual HOA meeting
  - b) The HOA budget and expenditures
  - c) How to become a member of the Board of Directors
  - d) Desire to create a new committee or special interest group
  - e) Ideas to Improve our HOA common areas
  - f) Appealing an ARB application denial
  
3. Contact the **ARB Chair** for the following (via email: [FoothillCrossingARB@gmail.com](mailto:FoothillCrossingARB@gmail.com))
  - a) Questions on how to complete and what to include on an ARB application
  - b) Status of an ARB application
  - c) Concerns about a neighbor's planned ARB project
  - d) Notification by the homeowner that an approved ARB project has been completed
  - e) Suggestions for changes to the ARB Guidelines
